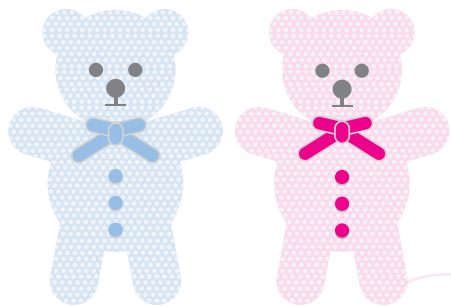


# CDHuggy Bear

# Teddy Bear Knitted Pattern

## CDHuggy Bear IN DOUBLE KNITTING



### Measurements

Teddy is 20cm (8 inches) high.

### Materials

Stylecraft Special Double Knitting.  
25g.  
A pair of 4mm (US 6) knitting needles.  
½ metre of ribbon.  
3 small buttons.  
Oddments of yarn for embroidery.  
Polyester filling.

### Tension/Gauge

22sts and 30 rows to 10cm (4 inches)  
measured over stocking stitch using  
4mm needles.

### Pattern notes

A little 8 inch teddy bear, knitted all-in-one,  
from head-to-head, in reverse stocking stitch.

### To knit CDHuggy Bear in Double Knitting

#### Head

Using 4mm (US 6) needles cast on 20sts and work 24 rows in stocking stitch.

#### Arms

Cast on 8sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 36sts.  
Work 8 rows in stocking stitch.  
Cast off 8sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 20sts

#### Body

Work 10 rows in stocking stitch.

#### Legs

Divide for legs.  
Work on first 10sts.  
Work 28 rows in stocking stitch.  
Break yarn.  
Rejoin yarn and work on second 10sts.  
Work 28 rows in stocking stitch.  
Break yarn.

#### Body

Rejoin yarn and work on all 20sts.  
Work 10 rows in stocking stitch.

#### Arms

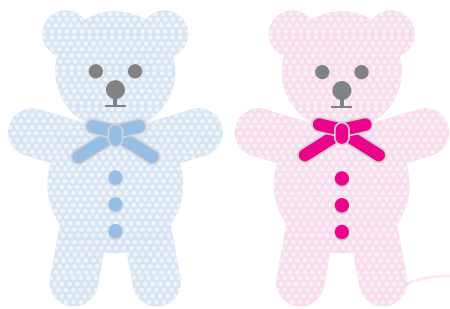
Cast on 8sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 36sts.  
Work 8 rows in stocking stitch.  
Cast off 8sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 20sts.

#### Head

Work 24 rows in stocking stitch.  
Cast off.

### To make up/finishing

Pin out to size, cover with damp cloth and leave to dry overnight.  
With right side out, wrong sides together, fold in half, matching arms, folding legs in half and pin together. Seam all round except for inside legs. Turn inside out. Stuff firmly. Join leg seams. Tie a piece of yarn firmly around neck and fasten off. Flatten the corner of the head with your fingers and sew a length of yarn along each corner at top of head for ears. Work the ears from the right side of the teddy. Embroider eyes, nose and mouth. Tie ribbon round neck and sew firmly in place. Add buttons.



# Teddy Bear Knitted Pattern

## CDHuggy Bear IN 4 PLY



### Measurements

Teddy is 20cm (8 inches) high.

### Materials

4 Ply yarn.

50g.

A pair of 3¼mm (US 4) knitting needles.

½ metre of ribbon.

3 small buttons.

Oddments of yarn for embroidery.

Polyester filling.

### Tension/Gauge

28sts and 36 rows to 10cm (4 inches)  
measured over stocking stitch using  
3¼mm needles.

### Pattern notes

A little 8 inch teddy bear, knitted  
all-in-one, from head-to-head in reverse  
stocking stitch.

### To knit CDHuggy Bear in 4 Ply

#### Head

Using 3¼mm (US 4) needles cast on 26sts and work 28 rows  
in stocking stitch.

#### Arms

Cast on 10sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 46sts.

Work 10 rows in stocking stitch.

Cast off 10sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 26sts

#### Body

Work 12 rows in stocking stitch.

#### Legs

Divide for legs.

Work on first 13sts.

Work 32 rows in stocking stitch.

Break yarn.

Rejoin yarn and work on second 13sts.

Work 32 rows in stocking stitch.

Break yarn.

Rejoin yarn and work on all 26sts.

#### Body

Work 12 rows in stocking stitch.

#### Arms

Cast on 10sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 46sts.

Work 10 rows in stocking stitch.

Cast off 10sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 26sts.

#### Head

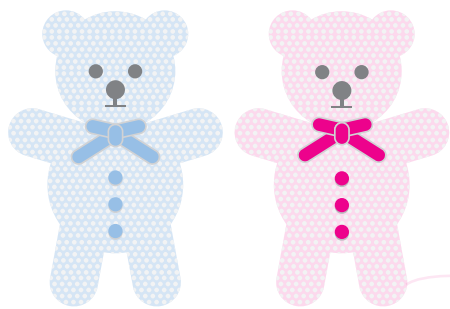
Work 28 rows in stocking stitch.

Cast off.

### To make up/finishing

Pin out to size, cover with damp cloth and leave to dry overnight.

With right side out, wrong sides together, fold in half, matching  
arms, folding legs in half and pin together. Seam all round except  
for inside legs. Turn inside out. Stuff firmly. Join leg seams. Tie a  
piece of yarn firmly around neck and fasten off. Flatten the corner  
of the head with your fingers and sew a length of yarn along each

## CDHuggy Bear IN CHUNKY



### Measurements

Teddy is 20cm (8 inches) high.

### Materials

Chunky yarn.

50g.

A pair of 6mm (US 10) knitting needles.

½ metre of ribbon.

3 small buttons.

Oddments of yarn for embroidery.

Polyester filling.

### Tension/Gauge

14sts and 20 rows to 10cm (4 inches)  
measured over stocking stitch using  
6mm needles.

### Pattern notes

A little 8 inch teddy bear, knitted  
all-in-one, from head-to-head in reverse  
stocking stitch.

### To knit CDHuggy Bear in Chunky

#### Head

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 14sts and work 16 rows  
in stocking stitch.

#### Arms

Cast on 5sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 24sts.

Work 4 rows in stocking stitch.

Cast off 5sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 14sts

#### Body

Work 8 rows in stocking stitch.

#### Legs

Divide for legs.

Work on first 7sts.

Work 18 rows in stocking stitch.

Break yarn.

Rejoin yarn and work on second 7sts.

Work 18 rows in stocking stitch.

Break yarn.

#### Body

Rejoin yarn and work on second 14sts.

Work 8 rows in stocking stitch.

#### Arms

Cast on 5sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 24sts.

Work 4 rows in stocking stitch.

Cast off 5sts at beginning of next 2 rows. 14sts.

#### Head

Work 16 rows in stocking stitch.

Cast off.

### To make up/finishing

Pin out to size, cover with damp cloth and leave to dry overnight.

With right side out, wrong sides together, fold in half, matching  
arms, folding legs in half and pin together. Seam all round except  
for inside legs. Turn inside out. Stuff firmly. Join leg seams. Tie a  
piece of yarn firmly around neck and fasten off. Flatten the corner  
of the head with your fingers and sew a length of yarn along each  
corner at top of head for ears. Work the ears from the right  
side of the teddy. Embroider eyes, nose and mouth. Tie ribbon  
round neck and sew firmly in place. Add buttons.

# How to make Teddy (step by step)



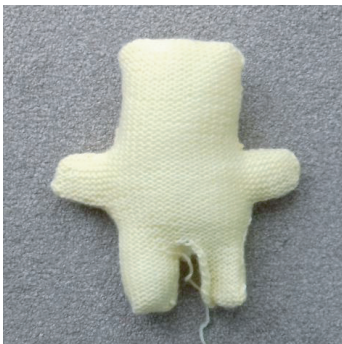
1. Knit, block fold & pin



2. Sew around, but omit leg seams



3. Turn right side out



4. Stuff



5. Join leg seams



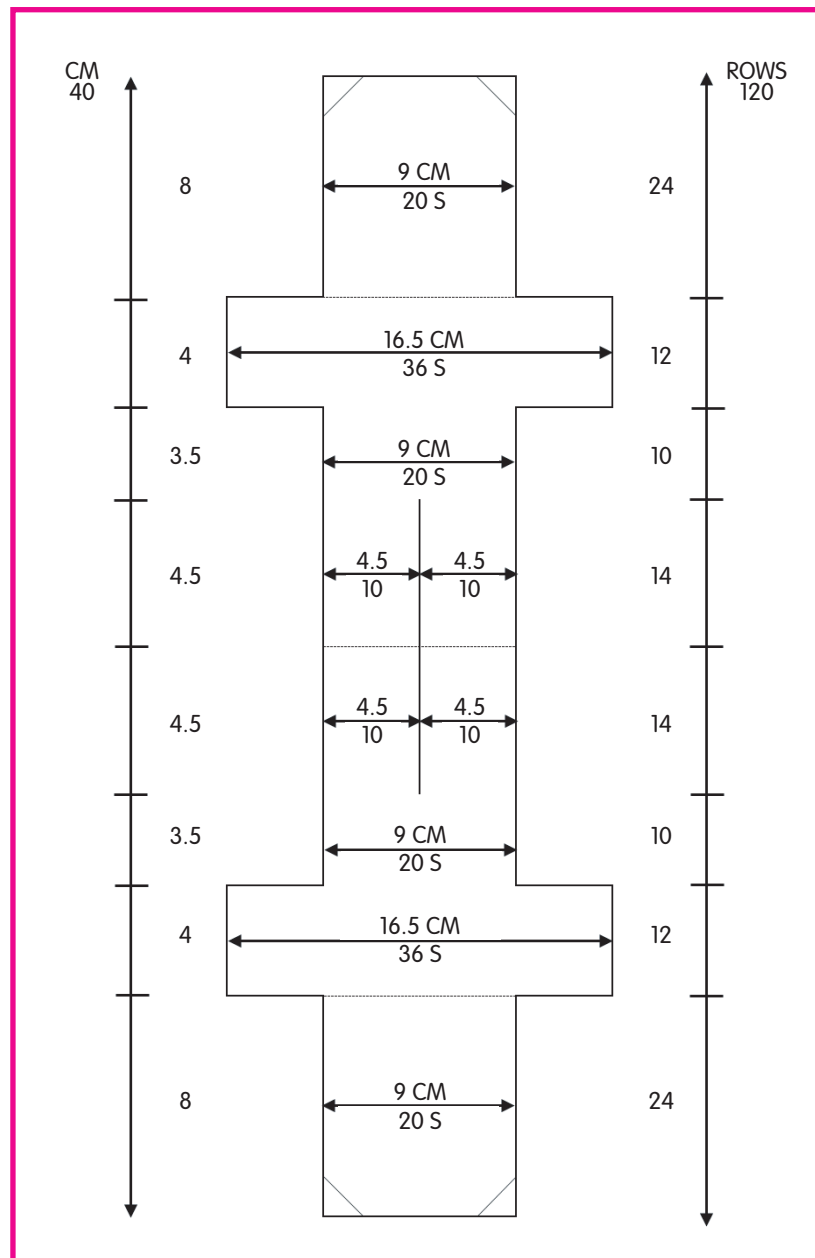
6. Tie yarn round neck



7. Embroider features and finish

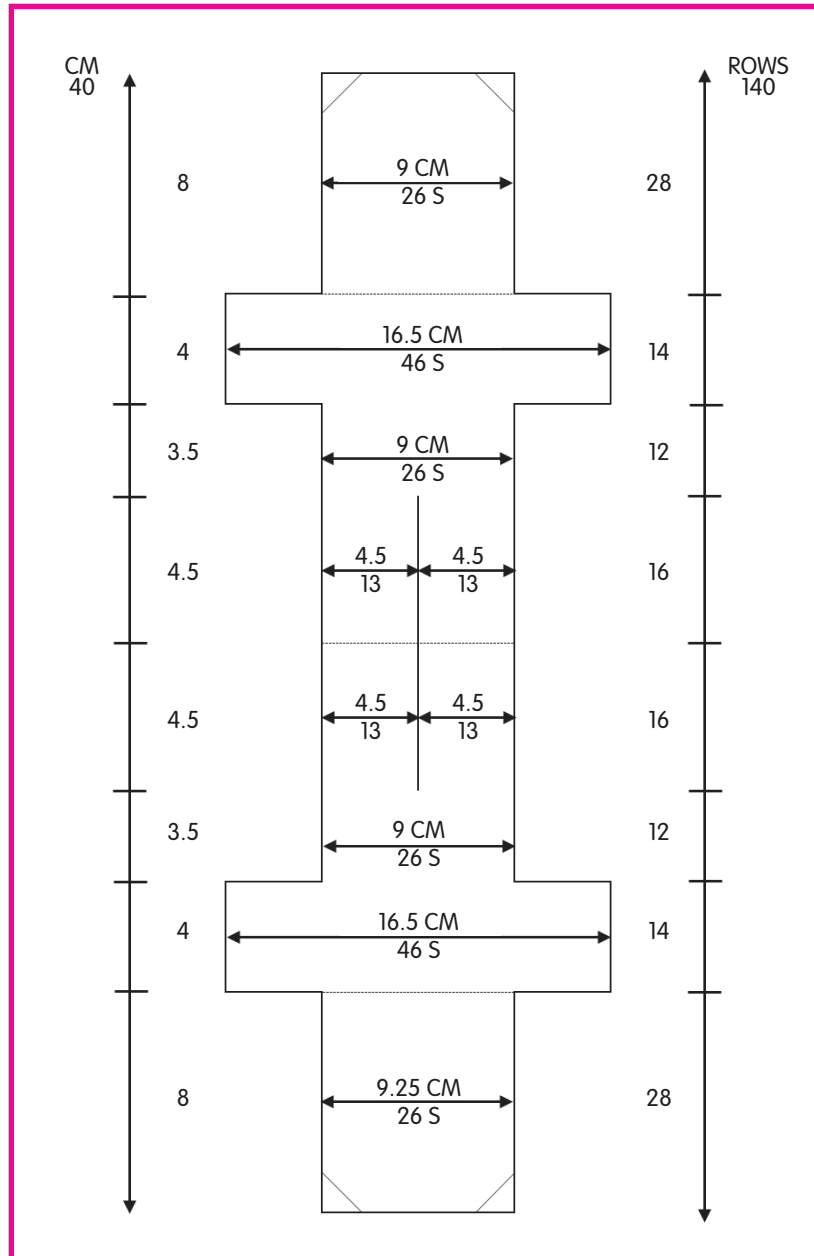

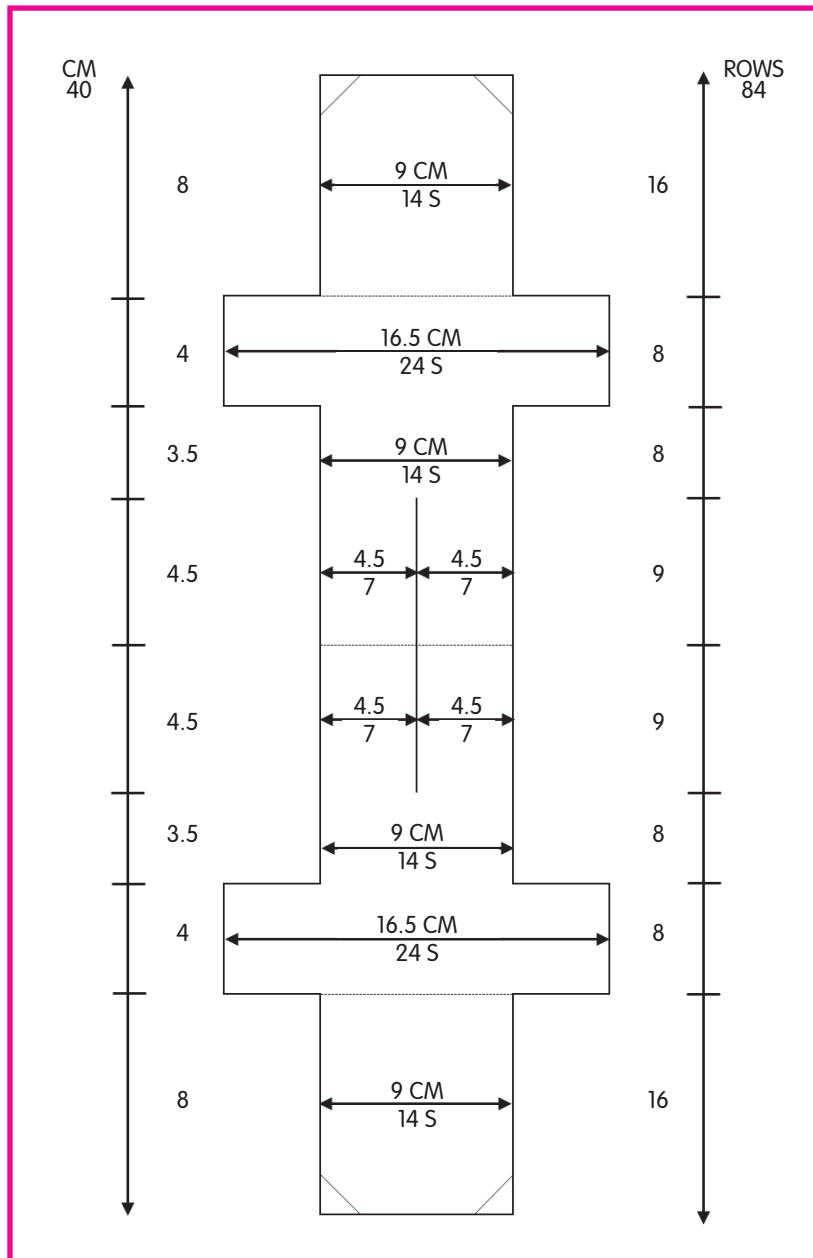

## STYLECRAFT SPECIAL DOUBLE KNIT WOOL



DK/8 ply (11 wpi)

Blend	100% Premium Acrylic
Ball weight	100 Grams (3.35 ounces)
Yardage	322 Yards (294 metres)
Suggested needle size	US 6 or 4mm
Suggested tension/gauge	22sts and 30 rows + 4 inches
